

Record notes of the Apex Council of Tripura Cricket Association held on 27th November, 2025 (Thursday) at 02:30 pm at the head office, TCA.

Shri Upananda Debbarma (acting President), Hon. Vice-President of Tripura Cricket Association presided over the meeting.

Shri Jayanta Dey, Hon. Joint Secretary and Shri Sani Saha, Invitee Member both were informed of the meeting but remained absent.

In absence of the President, the Vice-President is delivering as acting President and chaired the meeting.

The said meeting was called to order after ascertaining that the requisite quorum turned-up.

With permission of all the members present, the notice convening the meeting having already circulated was taken on record.

The Chairman of the meeting congratulated all the members present and addressed the house.

Agenda - 1

Confirmation of the minutes of last Apex Council meeting held on 15/10/2025

As per the first item (I) of the Agenda, the Chairman proposed before the house for confirmation of the minutes of the last Apex Council meeting held on 15/10/2025.

The said minutes was confirmed unanimously by the present members.

Agenda - 2

Finalization of Work of Construction of International Cricket Stadium at TIT, Narsingarh as per settlement under the verdict of the Hon'ble High Court of Tripura on 20/03/2025 - WP (C) No. 471 of 2023

TCA arrived at a settlement agreement through mediation of Hon'ble High Court of Tripura on 20/03/2025 to complete the work in all respect by 31st July, 2025. The agency fails to complete the works on 31st July, 2025. Both the parties appeared before the Hon'ble High Court of Tripura on 8th August, 2025. The Hon'ble High Court of Tripura heard both the parties and closed the matter by its order dated 11/08/2025.

The Engineer-In-Charge requested the agency to give a date of final measurement to finalize the work in terms of the settlement agreement. The agency has not given date of the final measurement. A pre-final running measurement (17th RA) has been prepared by including works done of finished items for INR 5,32,40,359.00, work done on part items for INR 6,08,83,028.00 and materials brought to site for which work has been done by the agency through vendors for INR 12,92,83,677.00.

Running value of work done as said above comes to INR 150,75,94,656.00 against total value under stipulated agreement of INR 185 cr. The agency approached for allowing time extension upto 31st March, 2026 for completing the work in terms of the settlement agreement. But the actual stage of appears is that speed of work before and after 31st July, 2025 is very slow. The agency is in progressive stage of execution for all the stipulated items for works.

The Apex was appraised by the Engineering section of TCA and evaluated in the meeting that the request of time extension upto 31st march, 2026 is not under the scope of settlement agreement or convincing on actual stage of work i.e. the ground raised on the plea of force measure hindrance is not convincing.

In such a situation it was resolved to request the agency to complete the progressive items of work as early as possible. Execution of the major extra items of works which has not been started by the agency will be executed separately by the Engineering section side by side.

Agenda - 3

Decision on execution of remaining works after finalization of the current work Construction of International Cricket Stadium at TIT, Narsingarh under the contract/settlement agreement.

The context of discussion for decision on this agenda comes from the discussion already made under discussion of agenda 2. 02 (two) extra items of works :- i) Stadiums' Chair, ii) Godrej Furniture.

Resolved to take-up side by side by application of proper technical and financial discipline for the interest of the speedy completion of the project. It was further resolved that for technical authentication of necessary procurement of stadium chair and Godrej furniture, the expert competency of Shri Tapan Lodh who was Retd. Chief Engineer of Tripura PWD will be utilized in addition to the consultant of TCA ALA Architect.

For general engineering assistance in planning procurement and execution, a technical committee of following 03 (three) Senior Engineers not below the rank of Superintendent Engineer may be constituted under the Chairmanship of Shri Tapan Lodh by taking consent from the all.

Proposal to procure 01 (one) Carrier van for cricket purpose

As a part of our ongoing initiatives to expand our outreach and improve mobility for our activities, we are planning to acquire a multi-purpose carrier van. This vehicle will be used for logistical support during domestic/National camps and other essential service-related mobility needs in rural and urban areas.

To make this initiative possible, it was resolved to seek the sponsorship from reputed banks under CSR fund.

Proposal to introduce Medical Insurance Policy/Health Insurance Policy for all the employees under TCA

It was resolved to prepare a detail note by the Manager Accounts of TCA by collecting all the necessary information and place before the Apex Council in its next meeting.

Agenda – 11

Decide on contesting claim on current Executive Committee for Gandacherra Cricket Association

It was observed that under the leadership of Mr. Dhananjoy Tripura as President, a certain committee of Gandacherra Cricket Association appeared before TCA, no other committee has attended the meeting to establish their validity by physical presence.

It was understood that no person belongs to Gandacherra Cricket Association is well aware about the constitutional activity of cricket administration. Thus, they were advised to intimate the management of Tripura Cricket Association about their validity as per constitution.

It means, they would conduct a Special General Meeting (SGM) in presence of the nominated representatives of their affiliated Clubs and Coaching Centers and form a legal executive committee along with Office Bearers.

Pursuant to the said advise they became active and constitute a legal & regular Executive Committee as per their Memorandum of Association (MOA) and submit all the necessary documents like meeting resolution, cover letter, list of nominated representatives of their affiliated Clubs and Coaching Centers along with their authorized personal identity to the office of the Tripura Cricket Association.

In the meantime, i.e. on 11/08/2025, another committee list was submitted to TCA by few certain persons, but without any legal supportive documents and other necessary evidence which could prove their regularity.

All the aforesaid matters were placed after scrutiny by the TCA officials in the Apex Council meeting held on 27-11-2025 to identify the valid committee of Gandacherra Cricket Association for acceptance by TCA. After a detail discission it was found that the committee under the chairmanship of Mr. Dhananjoy Tripura as President is valid and regular according to the submitted list of affiliated members of Gandacherra Cricket Association to the office of the Registrar of Societies, Govt. of Tripura with a copy to TCA in the year 2019.

It was also come to the observation of Tripura Cricket Association that the said committee runs the regular cricket activities in Gandacherra sub-division for the last 06 (six) months.

Therefore, it was resolved to accept the committee under the chairmanship of Mr. Dhananjoy Tripura as President as valid committee of Gandacherra Cricket Association until contrary to it is established through any legitimate claim.

Agenda – 12

Decide on proposal of Executive Committee given by Adhoc Committee of Kanchanpur Cricket Association by TCA

An adhoc committee comprising of the following three members was appointed by the TCA to run the local tournaments and activities of Kanchanpur Cricket Association.

The said committee was advised to perform for the interim period till constitution of regular committee and would coordinate for constitution of the regular committee of Kanchanpur Cricket Association within 60 (sixty) days and report to the Secretary, TCA. The stipulated period was already over and till date no regular committee has been formed.

It was further advised to give a report to accomplish the constitution of new committee by July, 2025 positively. That stipulated period was also already over and till date no regular committee has been formed.

In this context, after a detail discussion, it was resolved that the said committee will undeniably submit a report to accomplish the constitution of new executive committee of Kanchanpur Cricket Association within 30 (thirty) days from the date of issue of a letter.

Decide on contesting claim on Executive Committee for Sonamura Cricket Association

Whereas, there are contesting claims on Executive Committee for Sonamura Cricket Association and whereas, none of the contesting committees have been founded on the basis of membership list as required in pursuance to the adopted constitution for the association submitted in the year 2019 and whereas, the matter has been discussed in the Apex Council meeting on 27/11/2025 under agenda number 13 and resolved for derecognizing all the contestant committees as on date.

Therefore, it is hereby notified that all the contestant committees of Sonamura Cricket Association as on date are hereby derecognized w.e.f. 06/12/2025.

The works, the bills on expenditure will have to be supervised by the adhoc committee and processed through Office-cum-Accounts Manager of Sonamura Cricket Association to the Hon. Secretary of Tripura Cricket Association for effecting necessary scrutiny and approval forwards payment.

The Adhoc Committee will also supervise the performance of the Coach Shri Sandip Banerjee posted at Sonamura.

Payments will be made directly to the vendor/person concerns providing authorized services.

The Adhoc committee will coordinate for constitution of the regular committee of Sonamura Cricket Association within 30 (thirty) days and report to the Secretary, TCA.

Agenda – 14

Proposal to provide separate participation grant to Sadar Schools participating in Inter School Women's Invitational Tournament to be run by TCA

In every cricket season, a good number of schools situated in Sadar sub-division participate in Inter School Men's Tournament of TCA. It is observed that few schools also participate in Inter School Women's Tournament of TCA.

There is a financial guideline to provide participation money worth Rs. 25,000/- each to all participating teams of Schools in Inter School Men's Tournament of TCA in one cricket season. But no financial guideline for the participating teams of Schools in Inter School

observed in principle that if any School participates in single tournament of School cricket of TCA in one cricket season would be provided INR 25,000/- each as participation money. If any school plays both the school cricket tournaments run by TCA would be provided INR 40,000/- each as participation money in one cricket season. Other prevailing terms and condition for School cricket Tournament run by TCA will remain unchanged.

Agenda - 15

Proposal to provide participation grant to the participating teams in Under 18 age-group State Meet (two days) to be run by TCA

It was resolved that 14 numbers of teams of affiliated club's and 18 numbers of teams of affiliated Sub-divisional cricket associations will jointly participate in Under 18 age-group State Meet (two days).

All participating teams will be provided INR 2 (two) Lac only as participation money in one cricket season.

Other prevailing terms and condition any State Meet run by TCA will remain unchanged.

Miscellaneous

- i) Pursuant to the resolution of the Annual General Meeting held on 30th October, 2024, Tripura Cricket Association will organize CPR/First-aid Course by Indian Red Cross Society, Tripura State Branch in phase manner. The 1st phase will be tentatively commenced from 8th to 10th December, 2025 at Red Cross Bhawan, IGM Chowmuhani, Agartala.

Details of expenditure related with the said course is reflected below :-

- Hall rent of IRCS, TSB @ INR 2,000/- per day.
- Fees for candidates @ INR 1,000/- each.
- INR 20,000/- for allowances, conveyance and road side expenditures of the faculty members and resource persons for three days.
- Free accommodation of aspirants from sub-divisions in MBB Cricket Players' Hostel, Agartala.
- Non-AC Bus for the candidates from MBB stadium to the course venue.
- Breakfast, Lunch, evening snacks and dinner will be arranged.
- No honorarium, TA & DA for the aspirants.

- ii) In pursuance of the resolution of the Apex Council meeting held on 07/05/2025 a committee headed by the Hon. Vice-President of TCA was constituted for the Selection of Guest Cricketers and Support Staff about the selection of Guest cricketers and support staff for different state teams of TCA in connection with BCCI Tournaments during the cricket season 2025-2026.

After careful review of the requirements and considering the previous valuable contributions towards Tripura, the said committee has proposed to engage Shri Alok Deb Roy as the Head Coach of Tripura Under 16 Men's team in the cricket season 2025-2026.

Mr. Alok Deb Roy has been associated with the said team during the last cricket season too i.e. 2024-2025 and he was provided INR 5 (five) lac only as his professional fee for the entire contract period.

During this cricket season i.e. 2025-2026, as per his prayer and considering his contribution towards Tripura cricket and the team's performance in the last cricket season, the said committee has proposed 10% (ten percent) increment in his professional fee than last year i.e. 5,50,000/- (Rupees Five Lac Fifty Thousand) only for entire contract period for the cricket season 2025-2026 which shall be paid on equal monthly installments.

- iii) In pursuance of the resolution of the Apex Council meeting held on 07/05/2025 a committee headed by the Hon. Vice-President of TCA was constituted for the Selection of Guest Cricketers and Support Staff about the selection of Guest cricketers and support staff for different state teams of TCA in connection with BCCI Tournaments during the cricket season 2025-2026.

After careful review of the requirements and considering the previous valuable contributions towards Tripura, the said committee has proposed to engage Shri Ravindra Kumar as the Physiotherapist of Tripura Senior Men's team in the cricket season 2025-2026.

Mr. Ravindra Kumar has been associated with the said team during the last cricket season i.e. 2024-2025 and he was provided INR 11 (eleven) lacs only as his professional fee for the entire contract period.

During this cricket season i.e. 2025-2026, as per his prayer and considering his contribution towards Tripura cricket and the team's performance in the last cricket season, the said committee has proposed 10% (ten percent) increment in his professional fee than last year i.e. 12,10,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lac Ten Thousand) only for entire contract period for the cricket season 2025-2026 which shall be paid on equal monthly installments.

- iv) The 01 (one) year contract period of Shri, Subhadip Chakraborty, Junior Engineer (Civil), S/o. Shri Subhash Chakraborty, West Pratapgarh, A D Nagar, Agartala, Pin - 799003, Tripura (West), India of TCA will end on 30/11/2025.

After a detailed discussion it was resolved to extend the contract period of Shri, Subhadip Chakraborty, Junior Engineer (Civil) of TCA for another year with same remuneration as previous year.

There being no other further business and/or no content to discuss.
